Polio is a highly contagious virus which attacks children under the age of five and can cause paralysis and even death.

Rotary pledged to rid the world of polio back in 1985, when over 1,000 cases a day were being detected across 125 countries. In 2016, there were 37 cases worldwide in just three countries.

There is absolutely no cure, but a simple vaccine can prevent it. Each oral vaccine costs approximately 20p so your support may literally save a child's life.
