Revd Canon Dr Sarah Hills has been Canon for Reconciliation at Coventry Cathedral since 2014.

She was born in South Africa, brought up in Northern Ireland, qualifying in medicine from the University of Sheffield.

She worked as a psychiatrist, specialising in psychotherapy until her ordination in 2007. She was awarded her PhD in the theology of reconciliation at the University of Durham in 2015.

She is a Visiting Fellow of St John's College, Durham, and a Visiting Practice Fellow at the Centre for Trust, Peace and Social Relations at Coventry University.

She works and teaches in the areas of conflict and reconciliation in the national church and internationally, particularly in South Africa with post TRC reconciliation processes.

She is also director of the Community of the Cross of Nails which currently has over 200 partners worldwide.
