Caroline Millman became a member of the Rotary Club of Ringwood in 2001, was its President in 2006/07 and again in 2017/18, and District 1110's Governor in 2011/12.

Currently, she is an Assistant Regional Coordinator for Zone 18a, and Co-Chairman of the RI 2017 Zone Institute for Zones 15, 16, 17 and 18a in Riga, Latvia in October 2017.

With a background in training and development, project management, secondary and further education, and careers advice and guidance, Caroline has worked extensively with small and medium sized businesses, coaching, mentoring, and developing staff at all levels.

Caroline is also Chairman of PeaceJam UK, a peace education programme involving Nobel Peace Laureates, and is undertaking a PhD in strategic planning within the volunteer service sector at Southampton Solent University.

PeaceJam UK is an Affiliate of the international PeaceJam Foundation, the only organisation in the world that enables young people to work with Nobel Peace Laureates.

We target young people in primary schools, secondary schools, youth groups and universities from all backgrounds, but particularly we try to reach disadvantaged young people living in difficult and challenging circumstances.

Our programmes enable the development of key skills that lead to positive, personal change and the recognition of responsibility and efficacy, and that violence is not always the answer to conflict. We encourage young people to be active citizens and build their capacity to make a change in their school or local neighbourhood and from there have impact on the world around them. We inspire them to aspire.
